Unlike a simile which is another figure of speech that utilizes "like" or "as", a metaphor makes the comparison without the use of these two words. Examples of Metaphors in Poems | Examples A metaphor is a comparison between two things that states one thing is another, in order help explain an idea or show hidden similarities. Unlike a simile that uses "like" or "as" (you shine like the sun!), a metaphor does not use these two words. For example, in a famous line from Romeo and Juliet Romeo proclaims, "Juliet is the sun."
